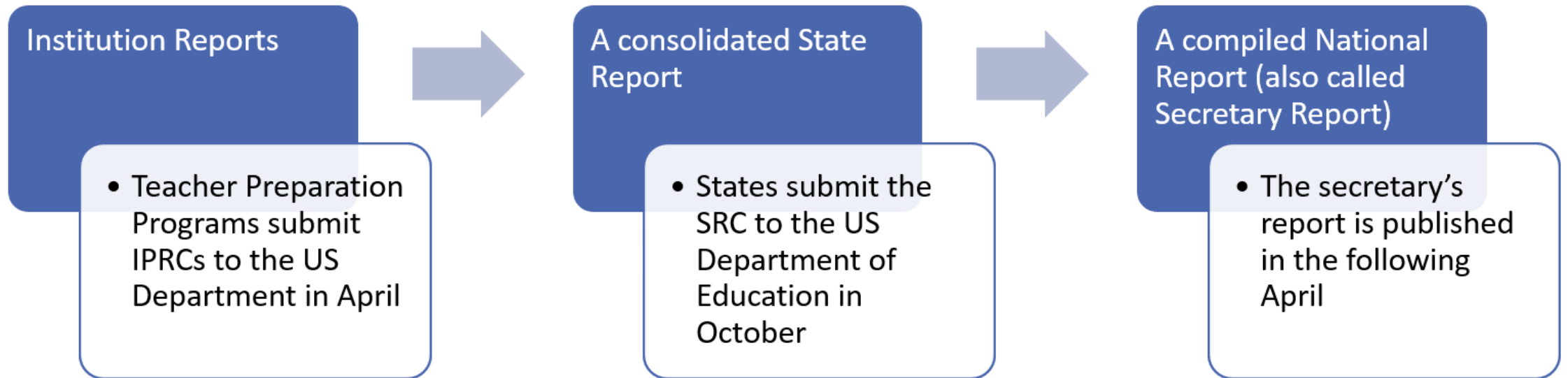
Title II report is mandated by federal law under Title II of the 1998 Higher Education Act

HEOA was reauthorized in 2008

Sections 205 to 208 call for accountability for programs that prepare teachers

When do we submit the report?

Three reports are developed for each Title II data collection and reporting cycle:



What is required in the Title II report?

- Title II report includes data on Multiple Subject, Single Subject, and Education Specialist credential preparation only
- The report does not include Designated Subjects or Services credential preparation
- Data are reported for candidates earning initial teacher credentials only
- Candidate data on added authorizations or subsequent authorizations is not reported

What types of reports are Teacher Preparation Programs required to submit?

1. Traditional Route (Student teaching programs)
2. Alternative route, IHE-based (University Intern Programs)
3. Alternative route, not-IHE-based (District/County Intern Programs)

2023-24 Report Highlights

2023-24 report highlights:

- Slight increase in total candidate enrollment in the Traditional Route
- More significant increases in total candidate enrollment in the Alternative, IHE-based route from the prior year
- More than half of total candidates identified themselves as non-White in all program routes
- Higher percentage of male candidates enrolled in Alternative route programs
- Higher percentage of teachers in the Alternative routes were prepared in special education
- More than half of teachers were prepared with the Social Sciences academic major
- Assessment rates varied slightly by route and segment

Figure 3. Map of Institutions in 2023-24

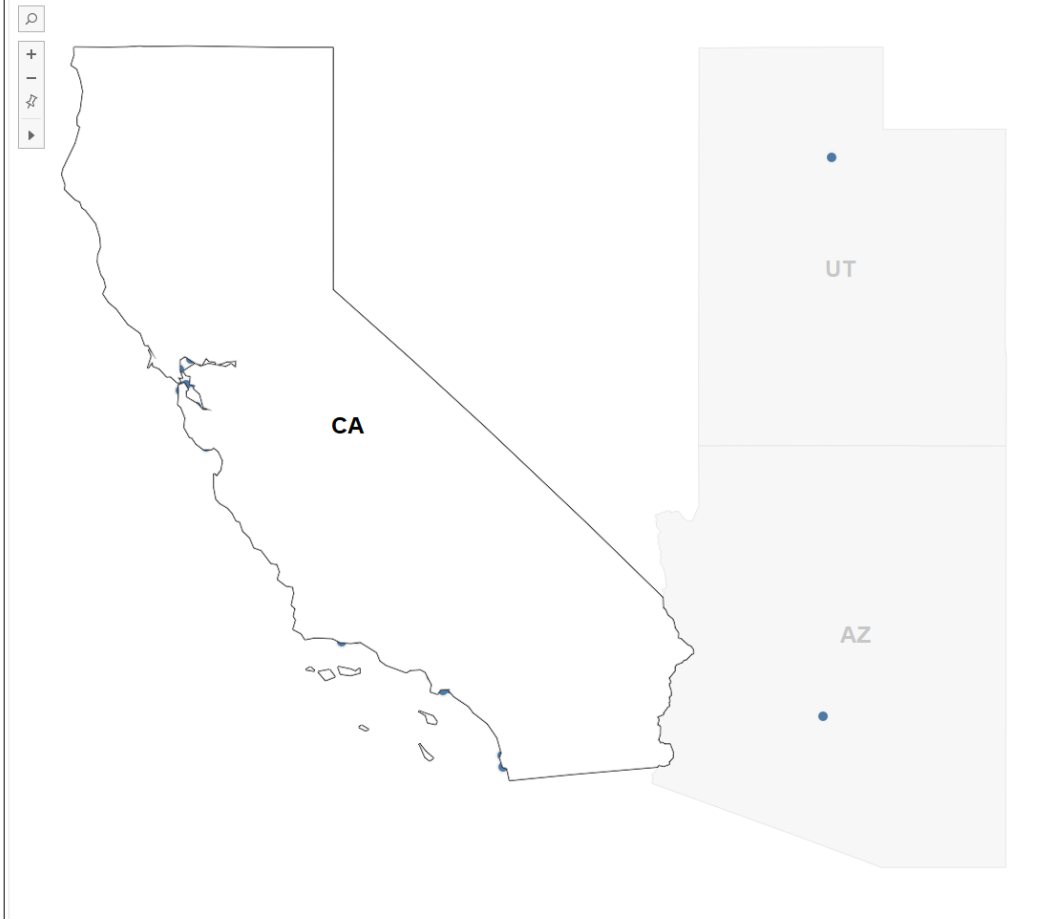


Figure 5: Total Reports Submitted in 2023-24

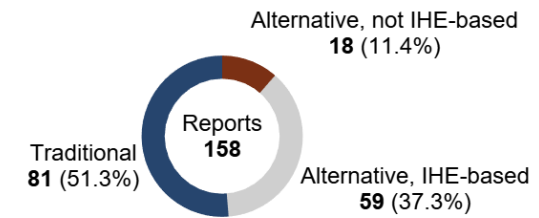
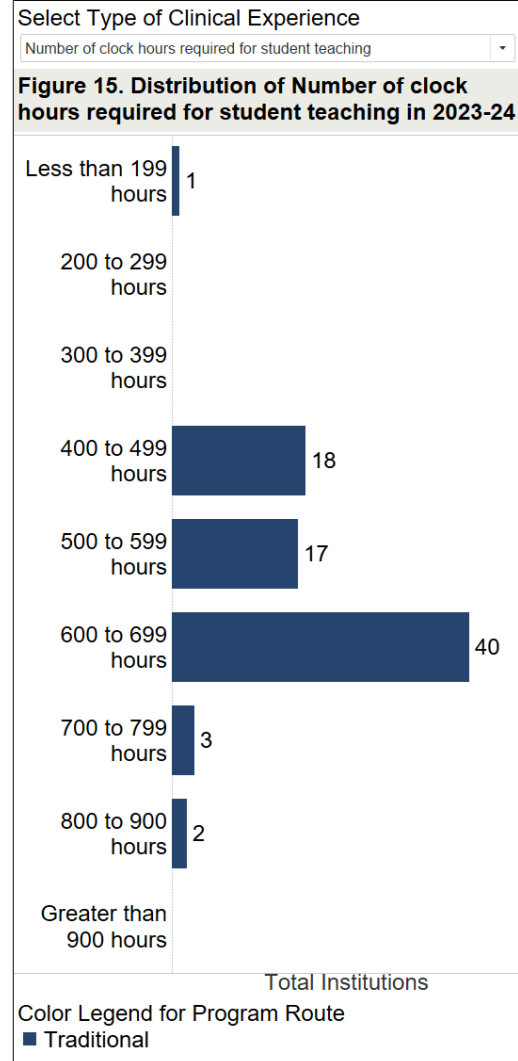


Figure 5a: Total Reports Submitted in 2023-24 by Institution Segment

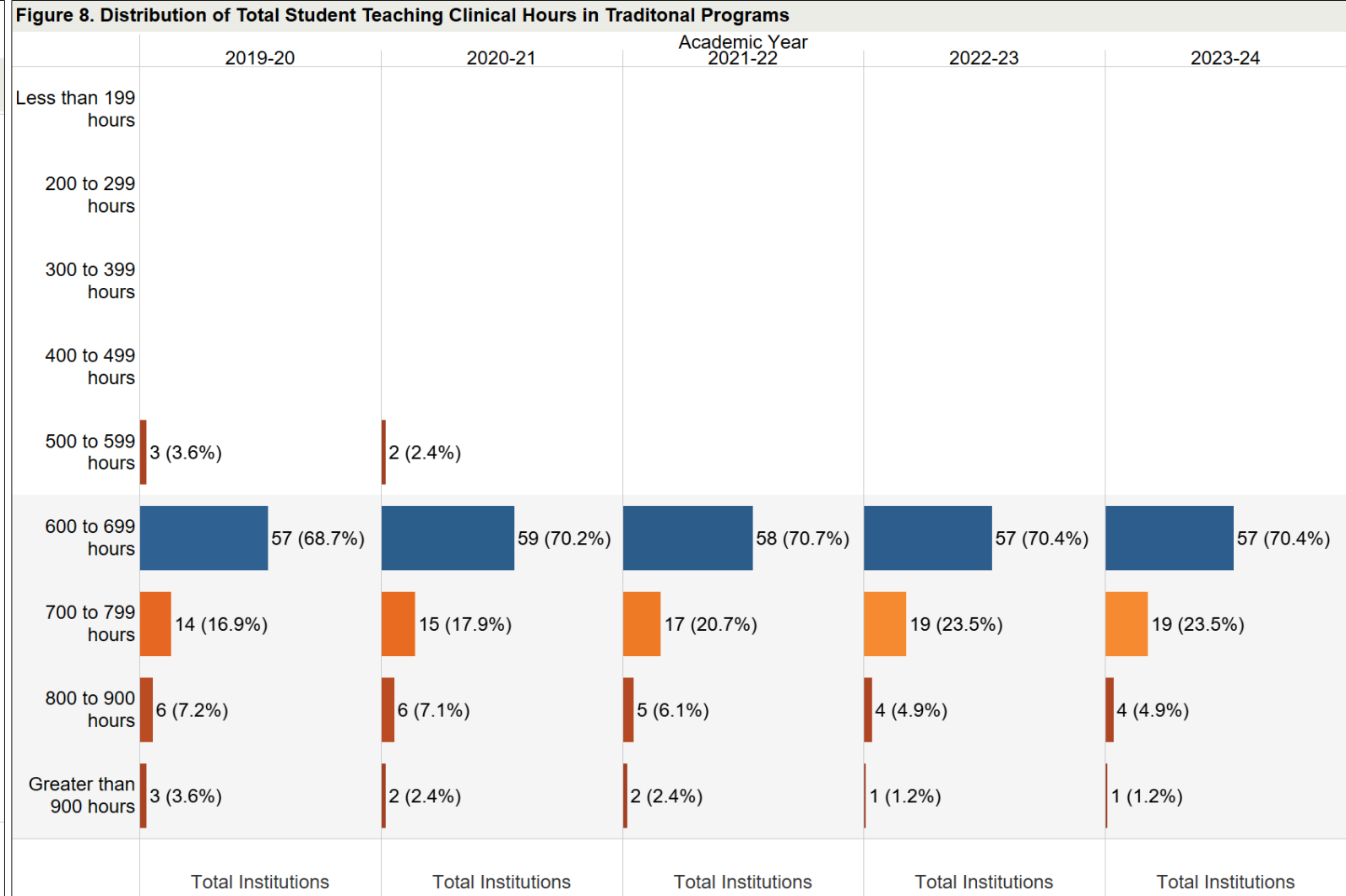

Figure 12. Total Enrollment and Subset of Program Completers by Gender Identity in 2023-24

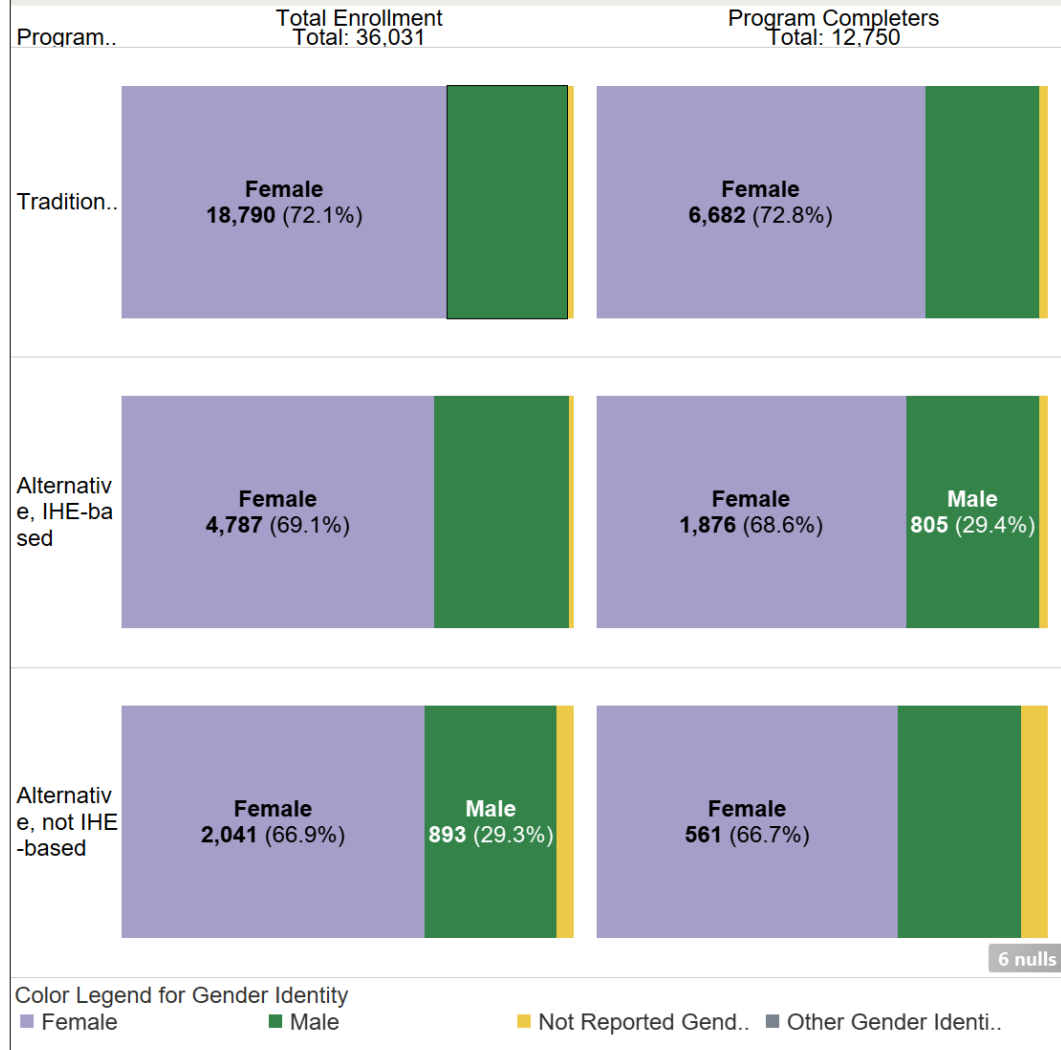
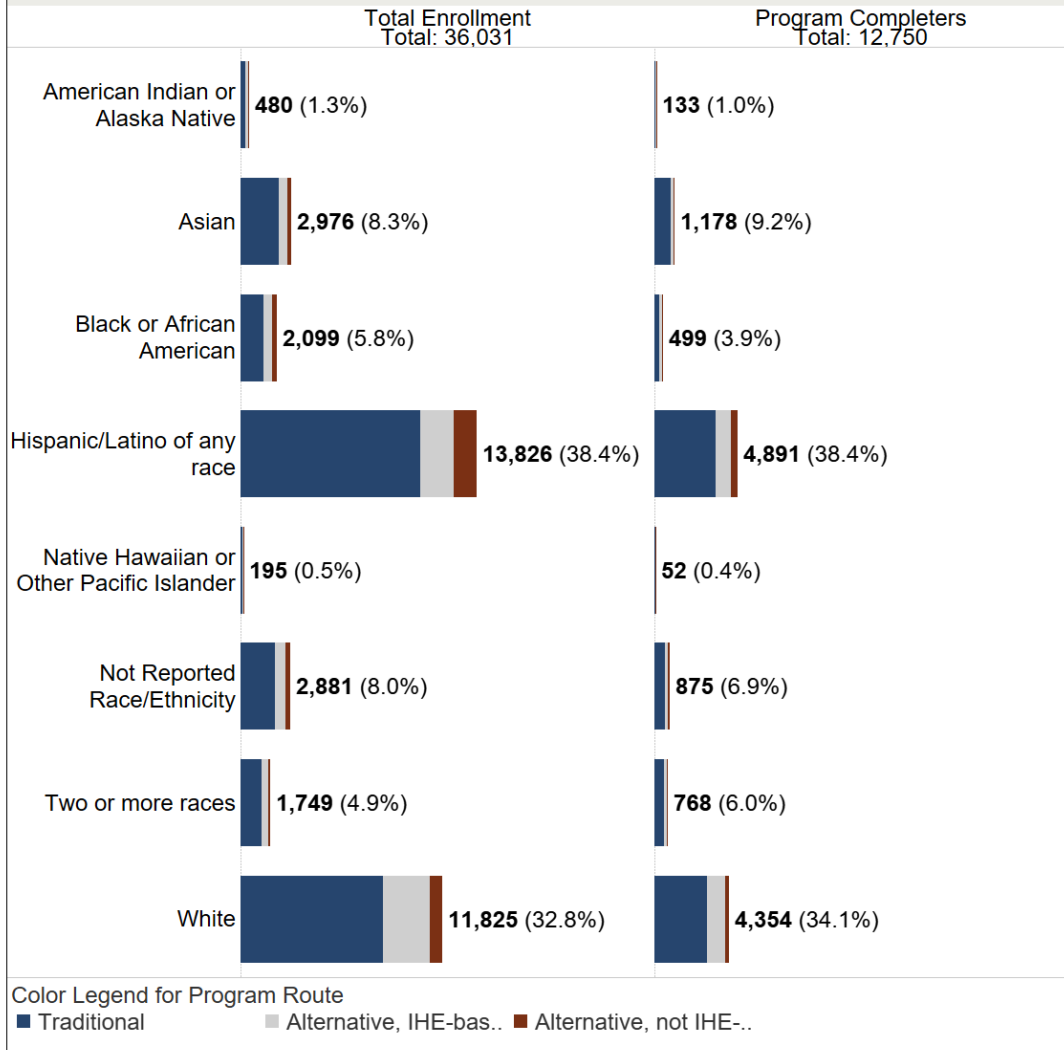


Figure 13. Total Enrollment and Subset of Program Completers by Race/Ethnicity in 2023-24

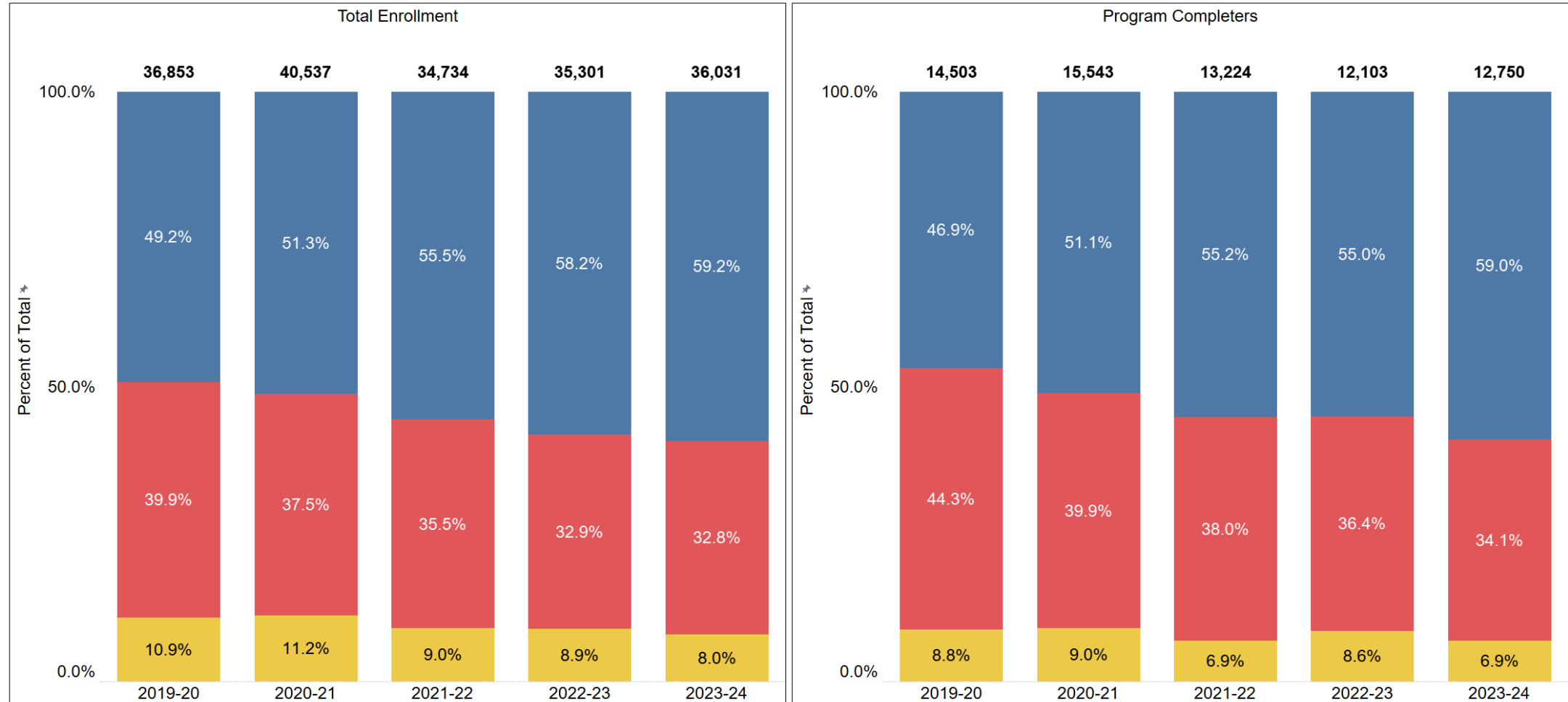

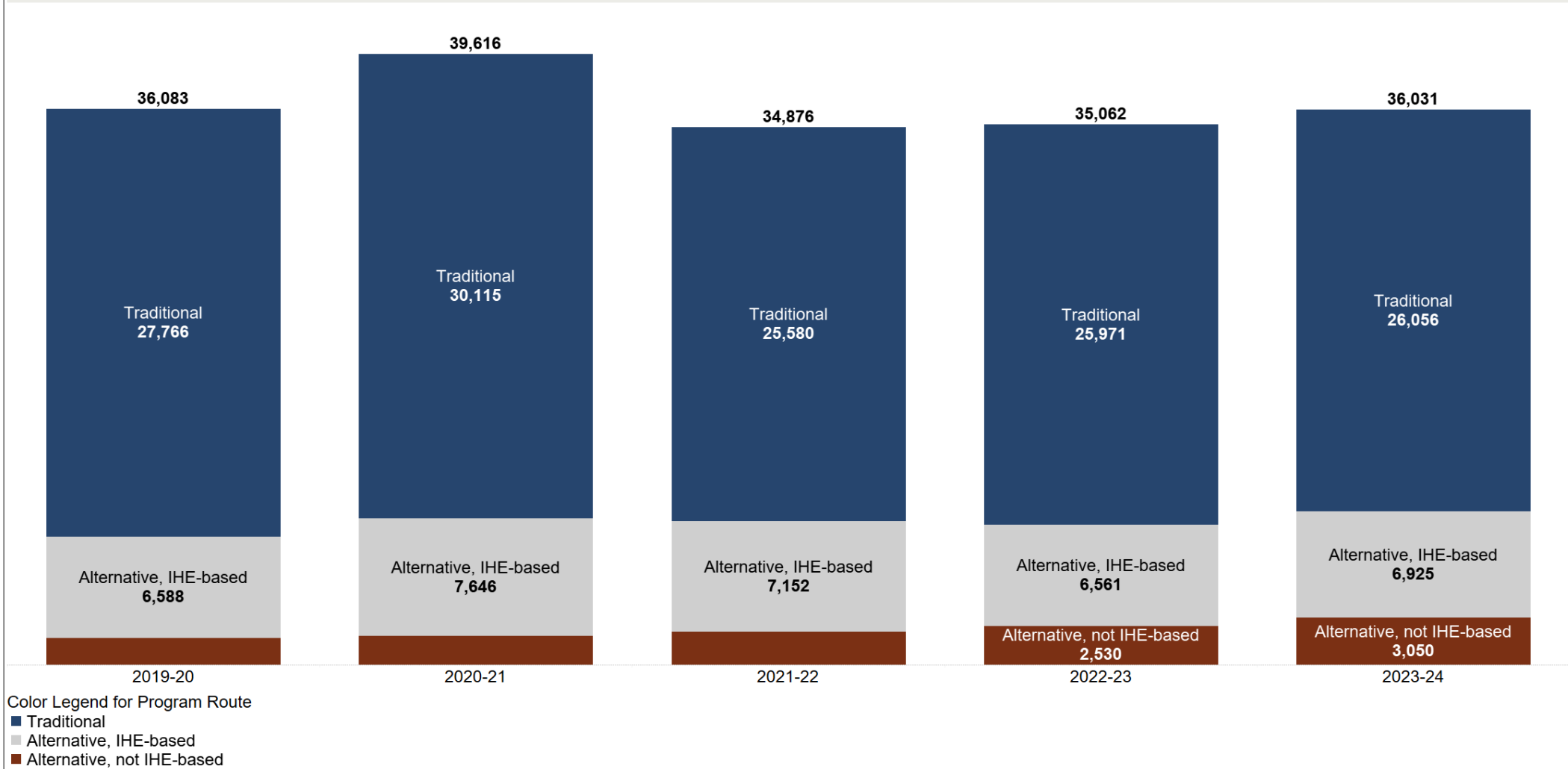

Figure 17. Teachers Prepared by Subject Area in 2023-24

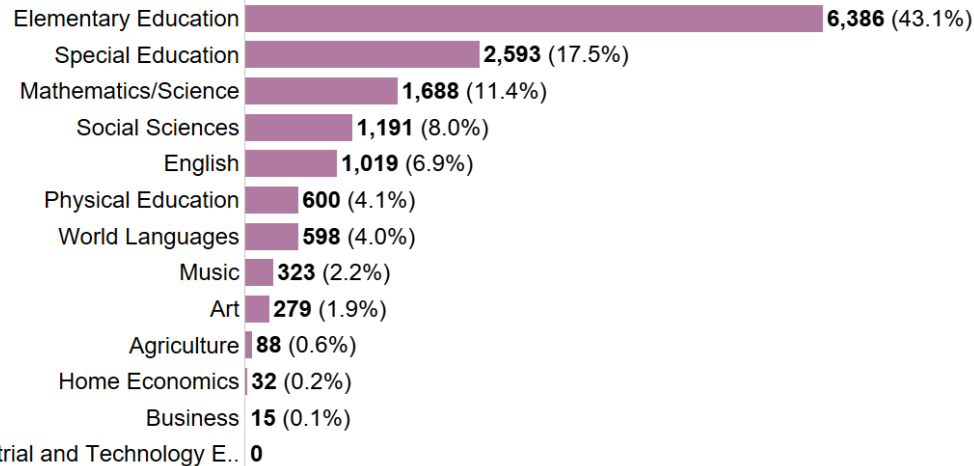


Figure 18. Teacher Prepared by Credential Area in 2023-24

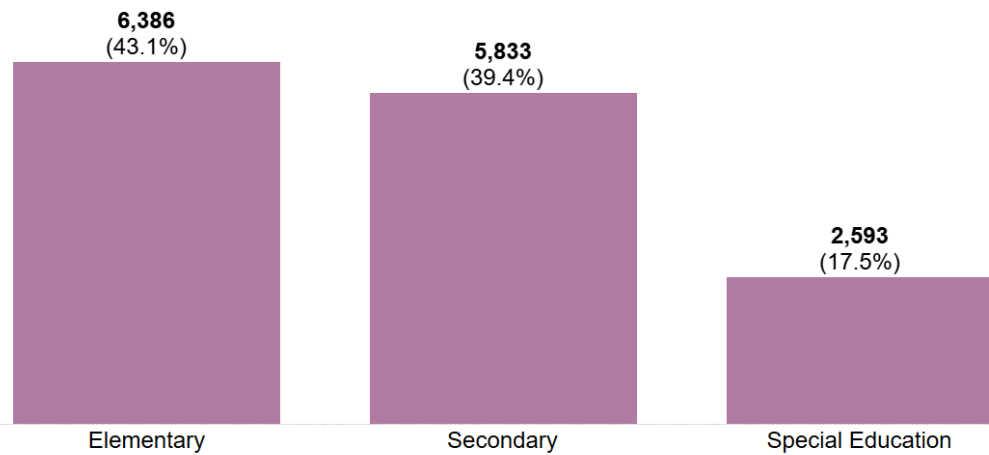


Figure 19. Teachers Prepared by Academic Major in 2023-24

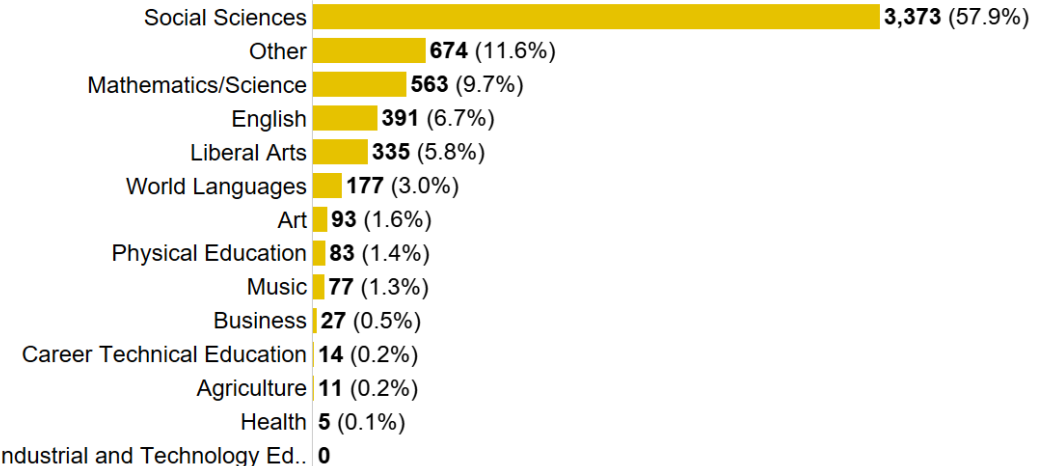
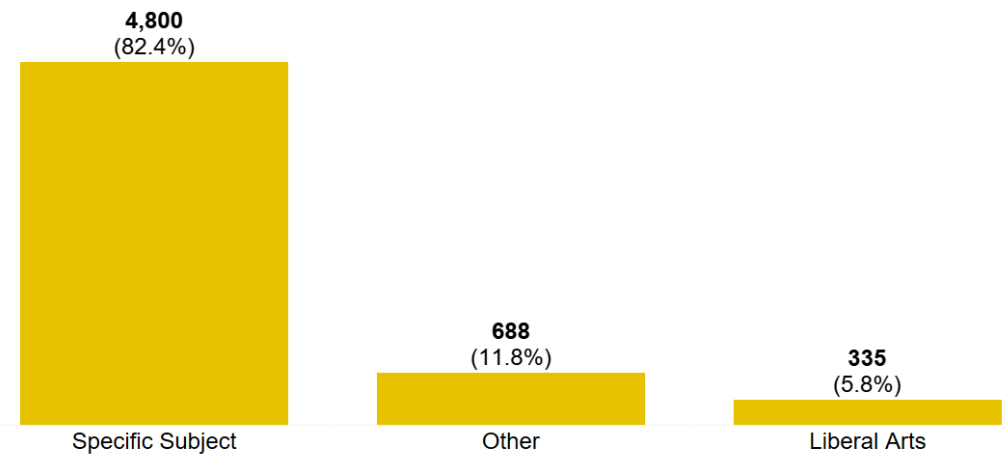


Figure 20. Teachers Prepared by Academic Major Area in 2023-24

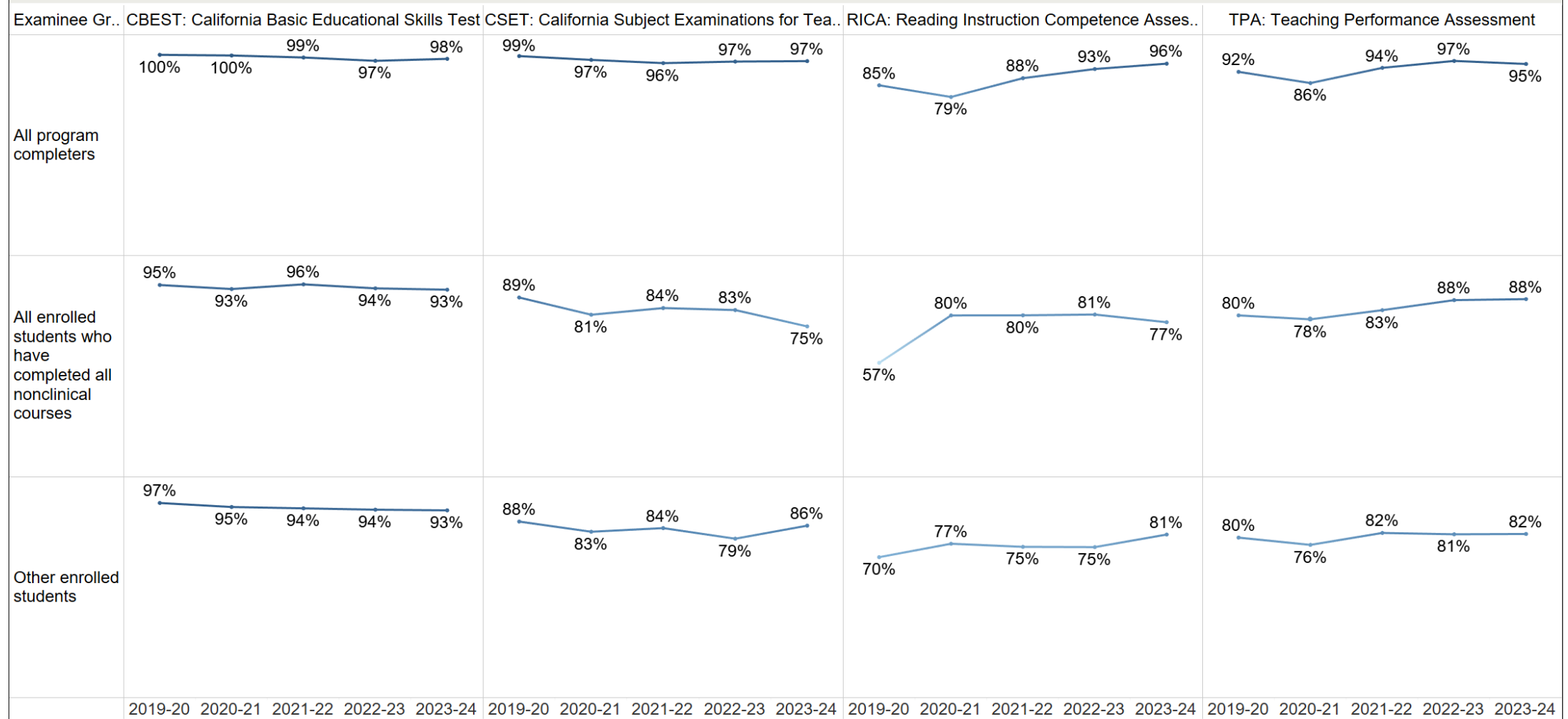
