

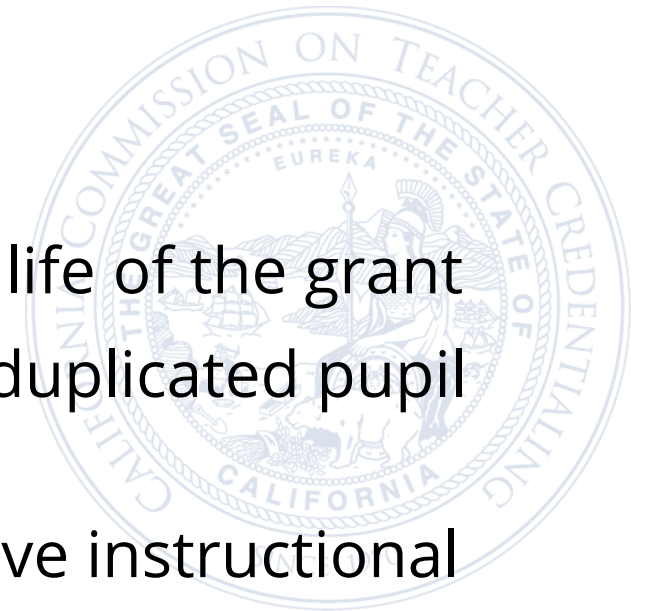

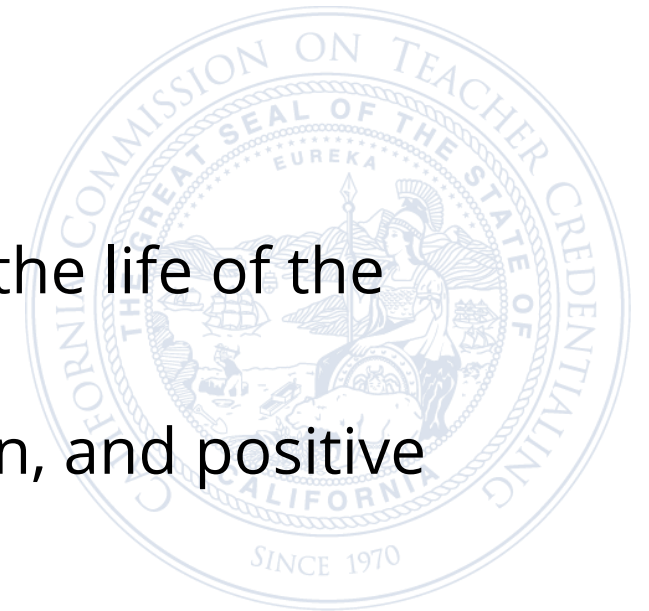
# 2021 COMPUTER SCIENCE SUPPLEMENTARY AUTHORIZATION INCENTIVE GRANT PROGRAM

- \$15 million one-time appropriation
- 20 LEAs funded across eight rounds
- Provides funding for over 1,100 teachers over the life of the grant
- Strong participation from schools serving high unduplicated pupil counts
- 2024-25 data show strong enrollment rates, positive instructional impact, and the addition of new computer science courses



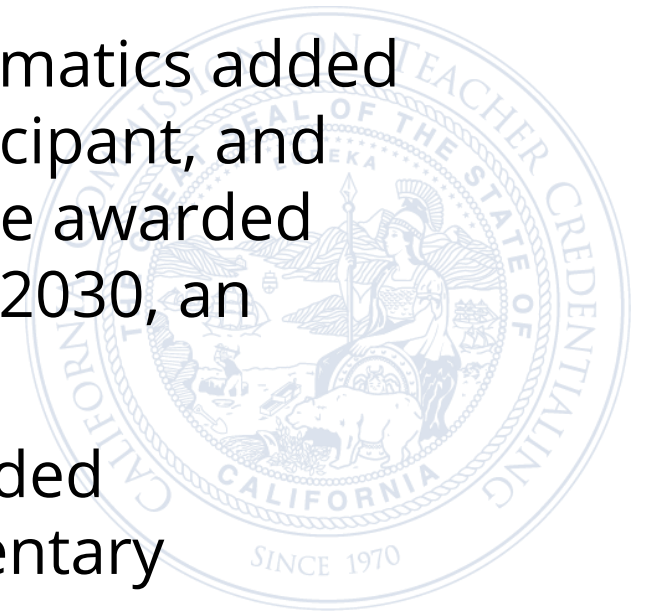
# 2022 READING AND LITERACY SUPPLEMENTARY AUTHORIZATION INCENTIVE GRANT PROGRAM

- \$15 million appropriation
- 10 LEAs funded across six rounds
- Provides funding for over 1,219 participants over the life of the grant
- 2024-25 data show strong enrollment, low attrition, and positive classroom impact



# 2022 READING AND LITERACY SUPPLEMENTARY AUTHORIZATION INCENTIVE GRANT PROGRAM- REVISED AND RECAST

- AB121- 2025- revised and recast to include mathematics added authorization, increase funding to \$6000 per participant, and reduced the match requirement to one third of the awarded amount and extended the grant through June 30, 2030, an additional three years.
- Program is now the Mathematics Instructional Added Authorization and Reading and Literacy Supplementary Authorization Incentive Grant Program.



# UPDATE FOR DIVERSE EDUCATION LEADERS PIPELINE INITIATIVE PROGRAM

- \$10 million competitive grant award
- 10 LEAs awarded
- Provides funding for over 365 administrator candidates over the life of the grant
- First year of implementation
- Very high enrollment rates and strong early outcomes
- 2024-25 data show that there is diversity among candidates, strong Institutions of Higher Education and non-profit partnerships and equity-centered leadership development
