

Discussion of Institutions Not In Compliance with Accreditation Timelines February 2025

Overview

This item provides information to the COA regarding institutions that have not complied with the timelines of the accreditation cycle. Over the course of the year, this item covers Common Standards submissions, Annual Accreditation Fees, Annual Data Submission, Preconditions and Program Review submissions. This year, staff is also reporting on the submissions for the SB 488 literacy certification review process.

Staff Recommendation

This is an action/information item.

Background

At the August 2014 meeting the COA requested information regarding institutions that are not complying with accreditation timelines. Since that time staff have been providing the COA with this information.

Update on Submission of SB488 Literacy Certification Documentation

At the October 2024 meeting, staff discussed the October 4, 2024 deadline for submission of the SB 488 literacy certification documentation. At that meeting staff notified the COA that extensions had been granted to institutions with extenuating circumstances. These extensions were granted through November 15, 2024. Ultimately, 20 institutions sought an extension. Since then, 19 of the 20 institutions have submitted the required documentation. The remaining submission has not yet been submitted due medical reasons. Staff have been in communication with the institution, and they will be submitting by March 15, 2025.
