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# New & Revised Assessments

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## New CalTPA Math Cycle

- Multiple Subjects (MS) + Education Specialist (EdSp) Mild/Moderate Support Needs (MMSN), and Extensive Support Needs (ESN)
- Multiple Subject and Education Specialist candidates are required to complete a math assessment, as outlined in the Performance Assessment Design Standards (PADS)
- Creation of Literacy Performance Assessment required development of Math PA
  - Incorporated learning from LPA


## Revised CalTPA SS & WL

- Revised existing assessments to align with changes reflected in LPA and MPA
- Goal to ensure have best possible assessments for candidates

Will become operational July 1, 2025

# Historical Use of Preliminary and Secondary Passing Standards

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## Preliminary Passing Standard History

- Set for first-year implementation of revised CalTPA (MS, SS, WL) in 2019
- Aligned with field test passing standards
- Informed by first-year data; followed by standard setting studies

## Secondary Passing Standard

- Approved in December 2023 for all TPAs
  - Initially set at –1 SEM
- Candidates within secondary passing standard may qualify for preliminary credential
  - Must demonstrate competence across all TPEs
  - Must meet all other credential requirements



# Current Operational CalTPA Passing Standards

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- Secondary Passing Standard applies to all CalTPA assessments *except* ESN
- Includes a **side condition**:
  - Candidates may receive **no more than one rubric score of 1**
  - If a candidate receives **two or more 1s**, they **do not pass**
  - Applies **regardless of total score**
- Candidates with multiple rubric 1s can **revise and resubmit**

# Proposed CalTPA Passing Standards

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## Temporary Passing Standard:

- **Score of 16 out of 40** points
  - Equates to an **average rubric score of 2** on a 5-point scale
- **No side conditions** (e.g., rubric 1 limit)

## Secondary Passing Standard (per Ed Code §44320.2(e)(2))

- Score of **14** serves as **secondary passing standard**

## Rationale:

- Supports a **developmental standard** during early implementation
- Enables **compensatory scoring**: stronger rubric scores offset weaker ones
- Reflects principles of **fairness, growth, and beginning teacher potential**

Both standards are **temporary** for 1 year

- PK3, MS, SS, WL, ES MMSN, ES ESN, ECSE, DHH, VI
- Standard settings held Spring 2026
- Results reported to Commission June 2026

# Staff Recommended Actions

**Adopt a minimum passing standard of 16 points across 8 rubrics, with no side conditions, for**

- Multiple Subject – Math cycle
- Single Subject Cycles 1 and 2
- World Languages Cycles 1 and 2
- Education Specialist: MMSN and ESN – Math cycles assessments

**Adopt a secondary passing standard of 14 points across 8 rubrics, with no side conditions, for all assessments**
